Informational Items:

High School Course Catalog – Dr. Polk informed the committee that LPS continues to work towards a high school course catalog. There is a draft in place but will ask Mr. Mattingly to have the high school counselors review it as well as Kim Elam. They are in hopes to have it completed and ready by November 2018. The final product will be placed on the LPS website.

Individual Career Academic Plan (ICAP) – Andrea Tracy, LHS, gave an overview of ICAP. ICAP is an ongoing process that includes a product that documents and reflects student awareness, exploration, preparation, planning and action for postsecondary success. ICAP is being implemented to close the workforce gap by 2025. It is intended to build student's self-awareness, vision for their future, explore and set goals and build personal financial literacy.
